Notice of Elective Positions to be Filled

A Petition has been filed with the Board of Trustees of the Cedar Mountain Fire Protection District (CMFPD) requiring members of the Board of Trustees to be elected, rather than appointed, effective January 1, 2010. Registered voters within the CMFPD service area are encouraged to participate in an election of CMFPD board members to be held in November, 2009.

This notice is to inform any person interested in appearing on the November, 2009 ballot as a candidate for the CMFPD Board of Trustees of the following:

Number of Vacancies:

The CMFPD Board of Trustees has seven board members. Candidates are being sought for all seven seats.

Qualifications for Candidacy:

To be a candidate for election to the CMFPD Board of Trustees, a person must be (1) an owner of land, or an agent or officer of an owner of land, within the service area of the CMFPD which receives services from the CMFPD and (2) a registered voter at his or her place of residence, which may be outside the service area of the CMFPD, and may even be outside the State of Utah.

Filing Requirements:

To file for candidacy, a person must file a Declaration of Candidacy, in person, at the CMFPD main fire station, 10 N. Mammoth Creek Road, Duck Creek Village, UT 84762, during office hours, 9:00 a. m. to 5:00 p. m., on any weekday, from and including Wednesday, July 1, 2009, through and including Wednesday, July 15, 2009. Failure of an otherwise qualified person to file a Declaration of Candidacy, in person within this time at the main CMFPD fire station, will disqualify that person from appearing on the November, 2009 ballot as a candidate for the CMFPD Board of Trustees.
